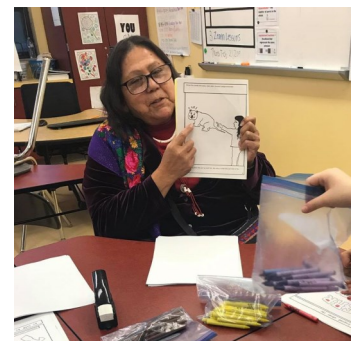

Session 3 Elective Information

Outside with 3-5: Third, fourth and Fifth graders will be learning new games to play outside.

Organized Recess Games: This class will teach students fun games to play when on recess and how to work together as a team.

Homework Club: Students will be able to do homework in this class.

Tech time with June: Students get the opportunity to explore online academics.

Esports: This is a sports competition using games for 6th-8th grade students.

Swimming Lessons: Students will be going to the Madras Aquatic Center for swim lessons.
